Eligibility

- Any nominated projects must have been completed between
 1 January 2023 and 1 January 2025 and all work must have been wholly completed by a Master Builder.
- Nominations for Outstanding Builder of the Year and Apprentice of the Year can be made directly by clients, colleagues, fellow FMB members or training providers. However, the apprentice or tradesperson being nominated must have worked for a Master Builder company between 1 January 2023 and 1 January 2025.
- Nominations for Business of the Year and Workplace Culture Award must highlight achievements and challenges that the company has faced between 1 January 2023 and 1 January 2025.






